

Telehealth allows you access to mental well-being health services from anywhere

This brochure provides an overview of the telehealth/virtual mental well-being programs and providers that are within our network and available for you.

You already have access to trained professionals for in-person counseling. But it's not always easy to find the time to talk with someone when you need help. With these services, you have another way to get help. And whatever you're facing, you have the same support: psychiatrists, social workers, marriage counselors and more. And one telehealth/virtual session will cost the same as an in-person office visit.

Plan coverage terms may vary. Not all benefit plans cover these services. Prior to receiving services, confirm telehealth and Teladoc® telemedicine eligibility by checking your member website for plan details or calling the number on your ID card.

- **Telehealth or virtual services (also known as telemedicine):** connects you and your provider via a secure televideo platform for counseling, support, education and medication management from the location of your choice. We require this via a televideo connection, not just a telephone call.
- **Medication-assisted treatment:** use of medications, with counseling and behavioral therapies, to provide a "whole-patient" approach to the treatment of substance use disorders.
- Peer support: service where trained people use their own personal/lived experiences to help others.
